Michigan, in 1995, with plenty of room for offices and additional assembly space. In an unfortunate turn of events, the move was followed by a devastating fire in January of 1997, resulting in a total loss for the company. Incredibly, this aggressive company rebounded much faster than the industry or the community anticipated. In just eleven days, Fan-Tastic Vent resumed production. Their current location in Imlay City, Michigan, has remained their headquarters following the fire.

Like a phoenix rising from the ashes, Fan-Tastic Vent's products are just as durable. Although Fan-Tastic Vent products have undergone improvements and feature enhancements over the years, reports Vice President of Sales David Struck, the basic purpose of their product still remains the same. Cool, clean, fresh air can be yours in seconds. The fan itself can move up to 1,000 cubic feet of air per minute providing a comfortable environment day and night.

With several fan models to choose from, for a variety of coaches, there are some basic features that come with each package, including a three-speed, 12-volt ceiling fan, a polycarbonate dome, and removable screen for easy cleaning. A fully automatic opening and enclosed dome accessory is also

available. Reverse models are standard. These models fit the standard 14" x 14" coach roof openings. The dimensions are 16-1/2" x 16-1/2" x 3-1/2". The rooftop weight is approximately 10 lbs.

Installation of Fan-Tastic Vent products and accessories can be completed in a short amount of time by the coach owner or through factory authorized vendors, like Camping World, or by contacting the Recreational Vehicle Dealers Association or the Family Motor Coach Association.

Installation involves replacing an existing static vent and tying into a nearby 12-volt power source. The fans are pre-fused at the factory. An easy to follow installation guide accompanies each unit.

Fan-Tastic Vent Corporation offers a full two-year warranty on their products. That means that they guarantee that their fans are free of manufacturing defects for up to two years after the original date of purchase or receipt of the product. The warranty, however, does not include damage to the product resulting from accidents or misuse. Easy to install and easy to use. Their theory resounds in their slogan that "Nothing happens 'til you turn the switch!"

Fan-Tastic Vent's staff reiterates that any customer who experiences a need for service or replacement parts should contact the company or their dealers directly.
